

Fire Police / Traffic Unit Equipment

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Resource

Type I Resource
For Any Application

Barricades, collapsible, minimum 24" wide (4 each)
Binoculars, HazMat Guidebook
Cellular telephone (personal cell phone is permitted)
Detour signs w/hardware, (20 each) omnidirectional arrow design (see note)
Emergency Scene Ahead signs with stands (4 each) (see note)
Fire Extinguisher, Dry Chemical (ABC), 10 lb minimum
First Aid Kit with pocket mask
Flagger Ahead (pictorial) signs with stands (4 each) (see note)
Flashlights, (2) Rechargeable, w/chargers and wands, or, (2) Flashlight w/wands & 2 sets spare batteries each
Floodlights Portable to illuminate FP @ TCP (2 each, with portable power source)
Fusees (2 cases)
Helmets (2 each)
Incident Command Board (White Board with stand/mounting, eraser and markers)
Radio, 2-way (home County frequencies)
Red warning lights & siren
Reflective graphics and lettering marking / identifying the vehicle
Stop/Slow paddles with 6' poles, reflective (2 each)
Traffic cones, 28-inch reflectorized, (48 each)
Vests, jackets, or coats, ANSI Level III (2 total)
VMS or Arrow Board, minimum size 30" x 60"
Yellow barrier tape (Fire Line - Do Not Cross; Caution, etc.) (2 rolls minimum)
Personnel – 2 (IFSAC or York County Operations Level Certified)

All equipment must comply with the MUTCD, PennDOT regulations, or other laws, standards, and regulations in effect.

With regard to Advance Warning Signs – coral is the color for Incident Management – orange is also currently permitted. Geography will determine sign needs. Size required is 48" x 48". Signs shall have flags or Type B lights added for visibility. In addition to the Emergency Scene Ahead and Flagger signs, other signs are recommended, and should include _____ Lane Closed Ahead (Right, Left, Exit, Turn, Center, etc), Detour Ahead, or Road Closed Ahead.

Detour signs – may be black on orange or coral background, or other color scheme. Arrow shall be 6" x 12" minimum and shall conform to standard shape/configuration similar to an R7-8 supplemental arrow.
